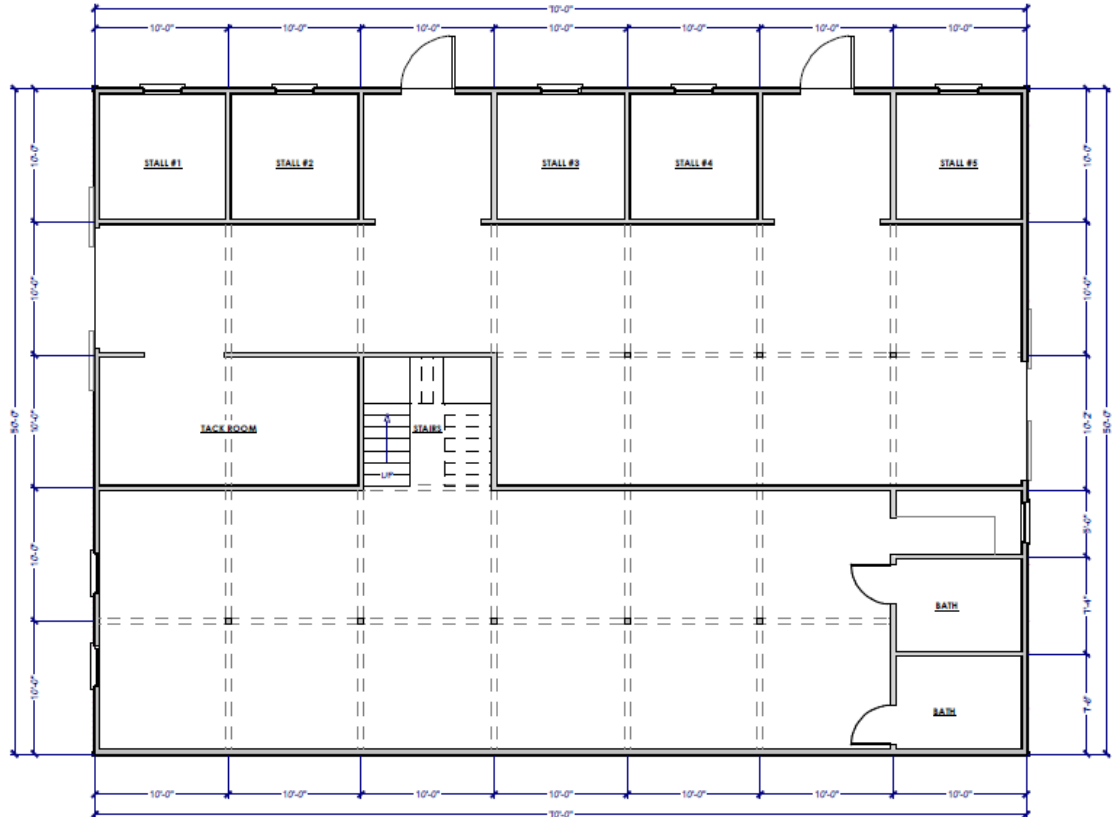

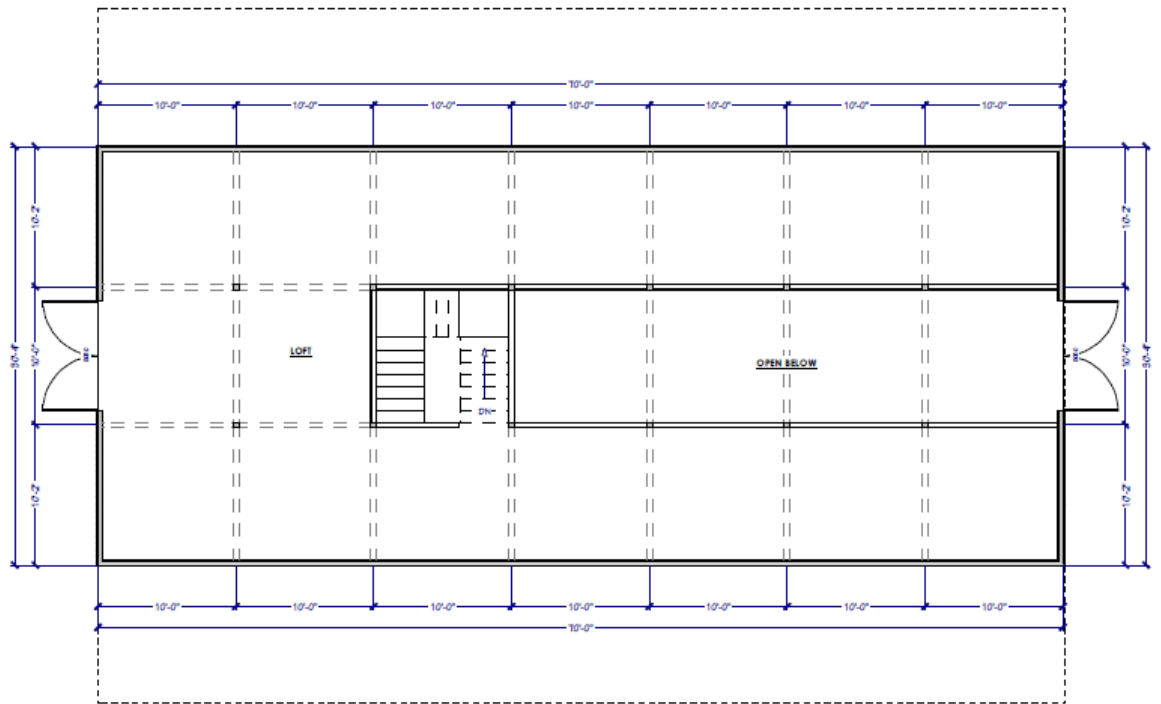

This barn is 50' x 70' with five stalls, Tack Room, Kitchen, 2 Baths, Presentation Room and a second story loft.

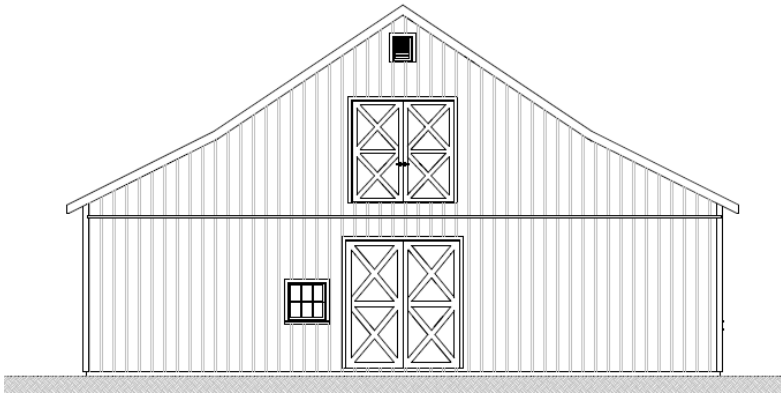


Main Level

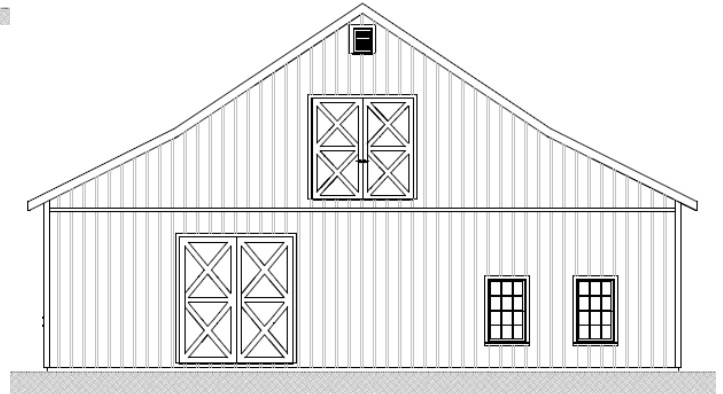


Loft Level

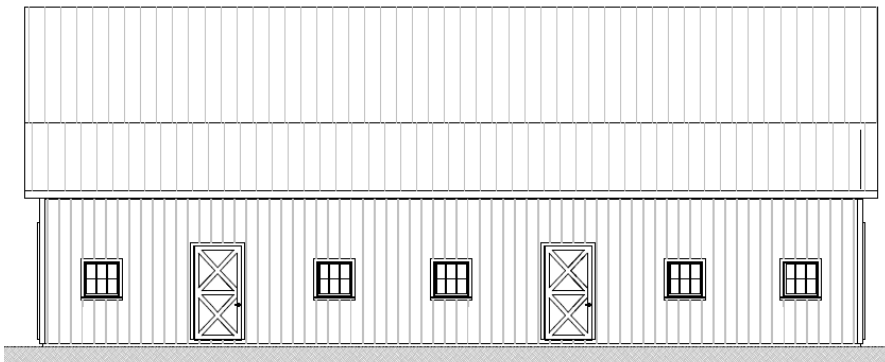

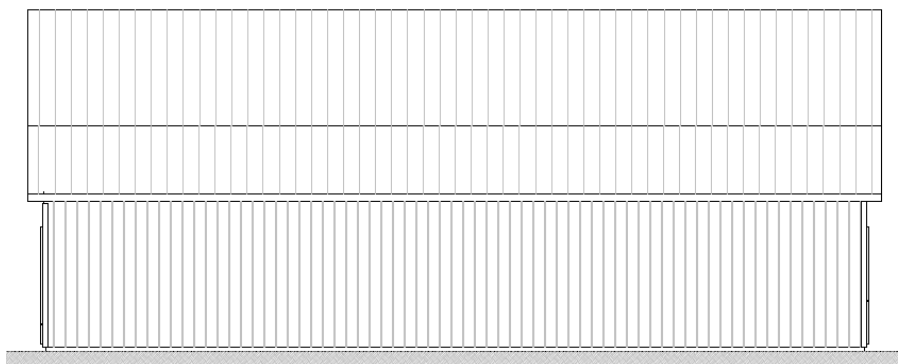
Front Elevation
